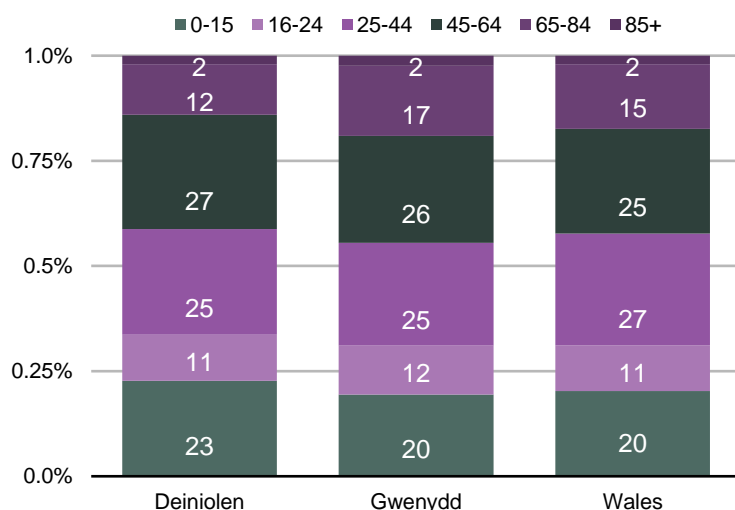

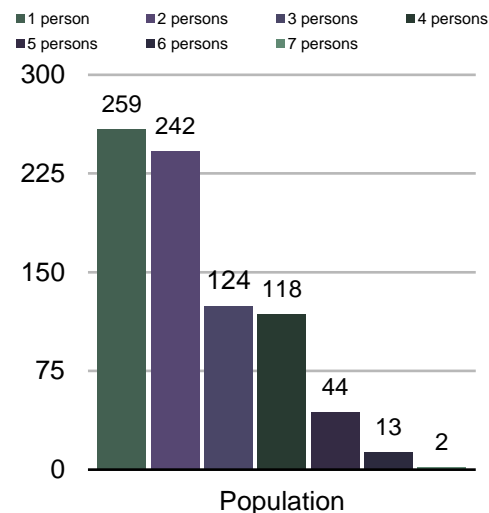

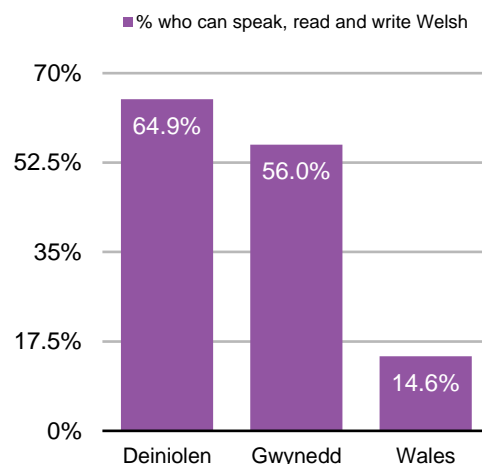

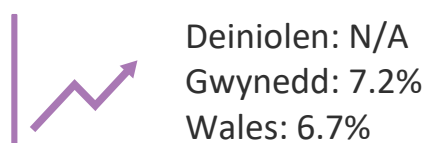

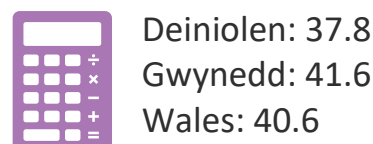

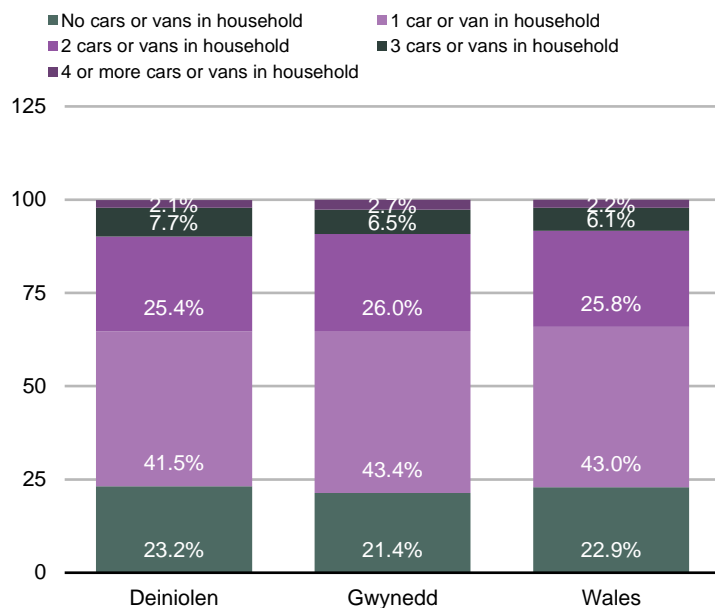

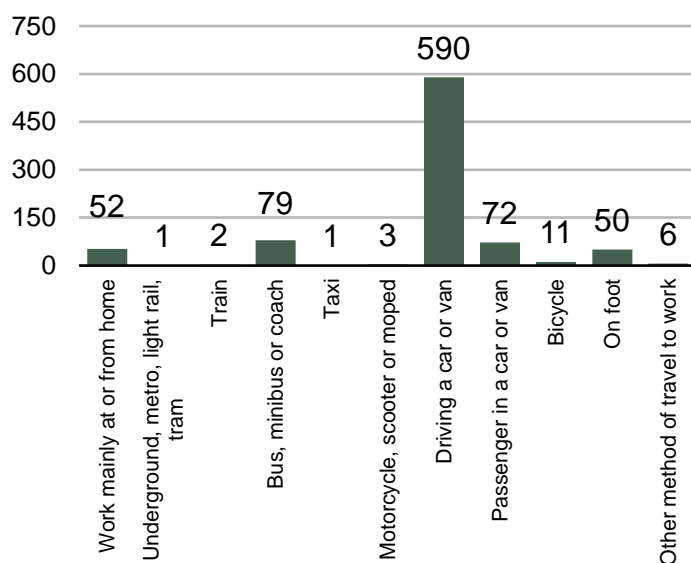




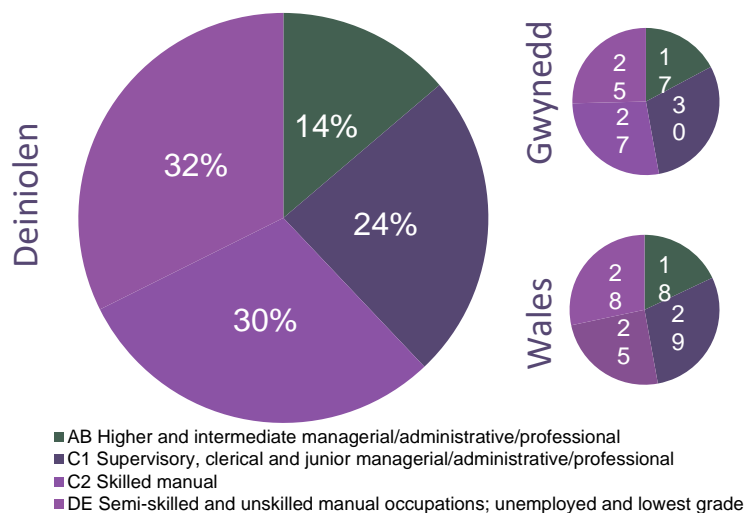
### Car or van availability by household (2011)

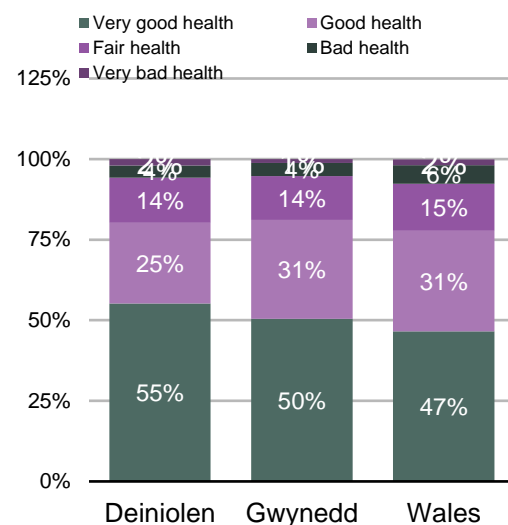

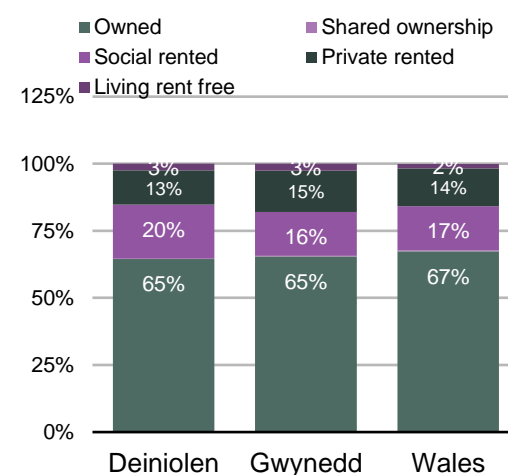

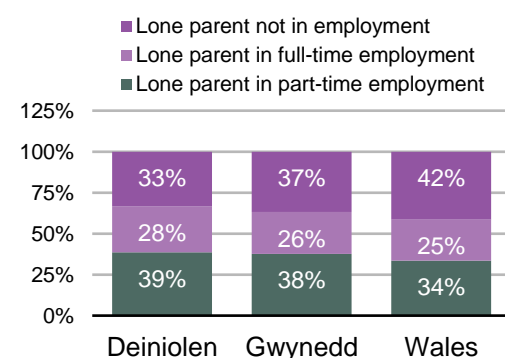
### Self-declared health (%) (2011)
